Re: Hinton Wood Products Forest Management Plan Submission Timeline

On the 10th of October, 2008, a meeting was held in Edmonton between yourself, Doug Sklar, Jim LeLacheur and Richard Briand regarding the submission timelines and expectations of the Hinton Forest Management Plan (FMP). By way of this letter, we are formally requesting agreement to proceed with the direction that was discussed at the meeting.

The Government of Alberta and the forest industry are facing several significant strategic planning initiatives, including the landuse framework, the water-for-life strategy and grizzly bear and caribou recovery programs. Given the high level of uncertainty related to these issues and the implications they may have on forest management planning, it is likely that an FMP would have a very short shelf life. However, the Government of Alberta and HWP are committed to mitigating the susceptibility of the FMA to Mountain Pine Beetle.

The decision was made that HWP would submit a "beetle plan" by September 30, 2009. This plan will focus on MPB risk reduction and will include the recommendation of a new AAC and address water, caribou, trumpeter swan and grizzly bear issues. A 5 year spatial harvest sequence will also be produced. We will complete a new landbase classification (using the new forest inventory) and will also create new yield curves for the timber supply analysis. HWP also agrees to complete an FMP that meets the requirements of the Alberta Forest Management Planning Standard by the end of September 2010, although we will jointly re-evaluate that timeline in September 2009 to review any developments related to the high level planning issues mentioned earlier.

On a related note, HWP and SRD have been working cooperatively on revising the Operating Ground Rules for the Hinton FMA area. This process is nearing completion and we look forward to having them approved early in 2009.

We would appreciate written confirmation that this plan is acceptable to the Government of Alberta. Please contact Richard Briand at 780-865-8181 if you have questions or would like to discuss this further.

I have received Mr. Briand's letter requesting a deadline extension for submission of your company's FMP from June 14, 2008 to September 30, 2009. The request is approved. While the department believes adherence to approved timelines is an important matter, the new information the letter mentions will result in a more informed plan.

Though the extension is approved, Hinton Wood Product's current Operating Ground Rules (OGRs) must be brought into line with the current policy Alberta Timber Harvest Planning and Operating Groundrules Framework for Renewal. Please work with the Forest Operations Section, Forest Management Branch to revise your current OGRs and have them approved by April 30, 2008. These revised ground rules can be further discussed during the development of the FMP, and necessary changes to the OGRs needed to align with the DFMP will be approved with the FMP in 2009.

Re: Hinton Wood Products 2008 Detailed Forest Management Plan

As you are aware, Hinton Wood Products has been working with your staff on the development of a new Detailed Forest Management Plan (DFMP) for the company's Forest Management Area (FMA). The DFMP is due for submission to Alberta on June 14, 2008. We have encountered several significant planning issues which have put our timelines at risk. These include:

- The new AVI for the FMA area is still not approved. The review and approval process to date has taken several months longer than expected.
- Uncertainty about the extent of any mountain pine beetle (MPB) infestations across the FMA. We are not currently aware of any naturally occurring MPB attack trees on our FMA. However, the situation immediately to the north of our FMA is of great concern to us. It would seem prudent to wait for the results of the aerial surveys this summer to determine the most appropriate direction for the DFMP.
- We are in the process of negotiating a new Forest Management Agreement with Alberta.
 Some changes to FMA boundary are likely to be identified which would have to be incorporated into the new DFMP.
- Caribou recovery plans are under development which may influence how we manage portions of the FMA.
- We have announced an enhanced planning process for the DFMP. A great deal of the work completed to date will have to be re-evaluated given likely impacts of the MPB. Some of the strategies that had been developed may no longer be appropriate. We need some additional time to consult with our stakeholders to find acceptable solutions to these challenging issues. We have enclosed a document which describes our enhanced planning process in some detail, for your reference and information.

We have invested significant resources into the acquisition of new digital elevation data for our FMA area. Secondary products generated from the new data will include improved watercourse mapping, more accurate identification of riparian areas and inoperable areas (steep slopes). These data will greatly improve our confidence in generating some of the inputs to be used in the landbase classification for the DFMP. These products were originally scheduled to be completed by October 2006. Unfortunately, the project has been delayed. We now expect to receive these products in June 2007.

We have re-evaluated our timelines and believe that we can submit a DFMP which will meet or exceed Alberta's requirements by September 30, 2009. By way of this letter, we are requesting your approval to amend the deadline for the submission of the next DFMP to that date.
