

Safe Food for Canadians Regulations Information Sessions

Do you import, export or market food products between provinces? Do you sell food to consumers at retail?

If so, the new Safe Food for Canadians Regulations (SFCRs) apply to your business.

The SFCR comes into effect on January 15, 2019. Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) staff will deliver four half-day sessions to help understand the new regulations and what they mean for your business. These sessions will focus on the new requirements for processors not previously subject to the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) registration system. The requirements will be phased in over a period of 12-30 months based on food commodity, type of activity and business size.

Each session will cover:

- Key components of the SFCR and how it will impact the food industry, including:
 - licences
 - preventive control plans
 - traceability
 - importing
 - exporting
- Timelines for implementation
- Enforcement and oversight considerations
- A description of “MyCFIA” and a walk through the registration process
- Available CFIA resources and guidance documents
- The opportunity to ask questions directly to a CFIA representative
