Instructions for Submitting a Sample

- Only veterinarians and veterinary clinics in Alberta may submit samples. For ticks from humans, contact your local [Public Health Clinic](#). Testing is free of charge. Samples can be submitted year-round.
- Shipping costs may be covered. Prior to shipping, contact the Agri-Food Laboratories at 780-422-4830 for details.
- Place ticks from separate animals in separate containers. Complete one submission form per animal.
- Ship ticks in sealed containers and packaging that can withstand shipping. Do not freeze or add holes or needles or fixatives to the container.
